

PUBLIC NOTICE

SPECIAL ELECTION—ALDERMAN DISTRICT 5, TOWN OF CHURCH POINT

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Alderman, District 5, Town of Church Point effective March 23, 2024;

WHEREAS, Louisiana law requires a special election to fill the vacancy for the office of Alderman, District 5.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MAYOR RYAN "SPANKY" MECHE, Mayor of Church Point, by virtue of the powers invested in me, do hereby order, direct, and proclaim as follows:

A special primary and general election for the unexpired term of Alderman, District 5, shall be held throughout

the jurisdiction of District 5, for the purpose of electing an Alderman for the Town of Church Point to fill the vacancy in the office.

Any qualified person desiring to become a candidate for the office shall file a notice of candidacy, accompanied by either a qualifying fee or a nominating petition, as required or authorized by law, with the appropriate election official in the manner and form, and under the procedures and conditions prescribed by law, during the period commencing on July 17, 2024 through July 19, 2024.

The special election shall be held and conducted under the applicable provisions of the Louisiana Election Code.

The primary election shall be held November 5, 2024; and the general election shall be held December 7, 2024.
